What is Sport Premium? Sport Premium is funding allocated to schools by central government. The funding amount schools receive is based upon the number children of primary age on roll at the school. Sport Premium is to be used to increase the quality and breadth of PE and Sport provision; increasing participation in PE and Sport and enhancing the skills of teachers to deliver high quality PE lessons.

At Kelloe Primary School we strive to promote healthy and active lifestyles and aim to provide a wide range of sporting opportunities for all our pupils.

In 2018-2019 the total Sport Premium funding for our school is £16,920
