

Deaf Hill Primary Sport Premium 2020 - 2021

What is Sport Premium?

Sport Premium is an amount of money which the government has agreed to allocate to fund additional and sustainable improvements to the provision of PE and sport, for the benefit of primary-aged pupils, in the 2020 to 2021 academic year, to encourage the development of healthy, active lifestyles.

At Deaf Hill Primary we strive to promote healthy and active lifestyles and aim to provide sporting opportunities for all our pupils.

The 2020 -21 Sport Premium funding for Deaf Hill Primary is approximately £18000

The money is used in the following ways:

- 1) **£7000** - Investing in the Easington School Sport Partnership Service Level Agreement.

This provides the school with the following:

- Liaise with the school to develop an annual bespoke P.E. & Sport action plan
- Providing curriculum support and high quality CPD for teachers, teaching assistants, NQT's, team teaching, twilights, professional development days etc.
- Provision of High Quality Coaching support across a variety of sports
- An organised annual programme of competitions/tournaments/festivals **in addition** to the National School Games
- Participation, inclusion and excellence opportunities
- Identifying the gifted & talented children in P.E & Sport
- Provision of an after-school activity in every term in a variety of sports
- SSP Network meetings to support PE Co-ordinators / PLTs in their role developing PE & sport within their school
- Identifying opportunities for young leaders to practise their skills through volunteering in schools
- Assistance in the process of applying for national 'School Games Mark' status for High Quality Provision of P.E. & School Sport
- Promotion and development of links to local sports club
- Sustain and grow the network of Change4life clubs
- Central co-ordination of school sport programmes in SSP area
- Use of KS1/KS2 Mini –gym equipment
- P.E Health Check

- 2) **£6000** - Mr. Football.

This provides the school with the following:

- Level 2 coach in school one day per week delivering Fundamental skills and movement to all children in our two year old provision, Early Years and KS1
- Bespoke sessions for specific children who need gross motor skill development

- A lunchtime football club
- An after school football club for KS2 children
- Curriculum support and high quality CPD for teachers, teaching assistants and NQT's

3) **£5000**

- Transport to and from sporting events.
- New equipment in school
- Coaching for specific events
- After school clubs

The Sport Premium Funding impacts the school in the following ways:

- Successfully up-skilling and training of school teachers and teaching assistants in the delivery of P.E in the school curriculum. Staff attending INSET training appropriate to their needs.
- Increased levels of participation across KS1 &KS2 through attending many different festivals and competitions across the local district and county competitions.
- Equipment purchased has allowed staff to deliver high quality lessons and after school programmes

All this impact is reflected in the Award of School Games Mark – GOLD for the past three years based on the following achievements:

- Young peoples' participation is tracked
- Having a calendar of competitions and festivals for everyone including SEND
- A highly visual school P.E noticeboard
- All pupils access at least two hours P.E every week
- 93% pupils engaged in extracurricular activity
- School promotes sporting activity to parents and the local community in newsletters, results, match reports, and the school website
- The school has entered 'B' teams in at least 6 competitions over the past year
- The school has entered 'C' teams in 2 competitions over the past year
- 19% of pupils have been involved in leading, managing and officiating over the year
- The school has a sports organising committee
- Sports coaches are utilised both in/out of curriculum time and this has led to the school having established links with 8 local sports clubs
